



WHAT DO I WEAR TO DANCE CLASS?

PRE-DANCE & COMBINATION classes – Any dancewear including leotard & tights, unitards, jazz pants with dance tops, etc. Pre-Dance students are welcome to wear ballet skirts, but please NO floor length skirts! **Hair must be secured away from face at all times.**

FULL HOUR BALLET classes (ages 7 & up) - PINK tights, BLACK leotard (any style/no skirts) & PINK ballet shoes **Note:** The dress code for Ballet is strictly upheld and without proper attire, including shoes, a child may be asked sit for a portion or all of class. **Hair MUST be secured away from face and in a bun.**

TAP, JAZZ, TECHNIQUE, TURNS & LEAPS & LYRICAL - Any DANCE or ATHLETIC attire including jazz or athletic style pants. Tops should be fitted, not baggy. Short shorts are permitted, but ONLY if tights or biker shorts are worn underneath! Dance shorts (aka Booty shorts) are permitted, but MUST provide full coverage!

HIP HOP - Baggy sweats/athletic pants or LONG shorts are recommended for HIP HOP. Absolutely NO tights, leotards or short shorts are to be worn in Hip Hop class. Baggy tops are permitted in Hip Hop. Please see individual Hip Hop teachers for more information on dressing appropriately for their Hip Hop class.

STRETCH & STRENGTH: - Athletic or dance wear suitable for exercising

REQUIRED SHOES:

Proper shoes are required at ALL times.

Without proper shoes, a student may be restricted from participating in class.

PRE-DANCE	PINK Ballet shoes & BLACK Tap shoes
COMBINATION	PINK ballet shoes & BLACK Tap shoes Note: Some Comb. classes may require Black Jazz shoes
JAZZ class	BLACK Jazz shoes (TAN slip on jazz shoes may be required for recital)
HIP HOP	Tennies – any style, any color
TAP class	BLACK TAP shoes
BALLET	PINK ballet shoes
TECHNIQUE	Jazz shoes
LYRICAL	Paws – some teachers also accept Jazz shoes – see teacher for details
STRETCH & STRENGTH	ATHLETIC tennis shoes - Keds, Converse & Vans NOT recommended
